



## Copthorne 2018 Calendar Competition

### Full Terms and Conditions

1. This competition is open to amateur photographers of all ages, living within West Sussex and Surrey. If an entrant is below the age of 18 years of age, their entry should be made on their behalf by a responsible adult/guardian.

2. All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.

3. Entries should be submitted by via email to [info@copthorneparishhub.org](mailto:info@copthorneparishhub.org). Images must be in landscape format. Entries must be labelled in the title bar with the entrant's name and age if under 18years. As the winning images must be of suitable print quality at A4 landscape size you should stipulate the following:

Image files must be high resolution minimum 2480 x 3500 pixels and at 300dpi RGB (cameras) at A4 size or high resolution JPEG (smartphones) file. Please note that when emailing images taken with a smartphone, the file must be "actual size" and not reduced. Entrants should include their own name, address, telephone number and where the image was taken. We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries.

4. All entries must be received by the advertised closing time and date. This will differ depending on the month so please check the Facebook page for more information.

5. All images submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them and must not have been published elsewhere or have won a prize in any other photographic competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it. **ALL IMAGES MUST BE TAKEN WITHIN COPTHORNE VILLAGE.**

6. Copyright in all images submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, in consideration of their providing the Competition, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual license to the organiser, Copthorne Parish Hub to feature any or all of the submitted images in any of their publications, their websites, social media and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition and including the 2018 Copthorne Calendar.

7. Only one entry per person, per month. Late, illegible, incomplete, defaced or corrupt entries will not be accepted. No responsibility can be accepted for lost entries and proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt. Entries must not be sent through agencies.

8. The winning entries will be those that are judged to be the most visually appealing, original and self-explanatory. The winner will be notified within seven days of the closing date of the competition. The entries will be judged by an impartial, professional photographer.

9. Entry to the competition is free and there will be a prize supplied each month by different local companies.

10. The winners name and county (age if under 18 years) will be used alongside their winning image on social media, websites, publications and promotional materials and they may be required to take part in publicity.

11. The winner's name and county may be disclosed to anyone who writes within one month after the published closing date, stating the date of publication and enclosing a stamped addressed envelope, to The Copthorne 2018 Calendar Competition Winner, c/o Kate Bagnall, Parish Office, The Vicarage, Church Road, Copthorne, West Sussex

12. The prizes as described are available on the date of publication. All prizes are non-transferable and there are no cash alternatives.

13. Events may occur that render the competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the organiser and accordingly the organiser may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the promotion and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the organiser as a result thereof.

14. The Copthorne Parish Hub is responsible for the publication and adjudication of the competition along with the print production of the 2018 Copthorne Calendar. All other facilities connected with the provision of the prizes are the responsibility of the local companies.

15. There will also be an overall winner whose image will appear on the front cover of the calendar as well as inside. They will receive an additional prize as yet to be confirmed.

16. The organiser reserves the right to amend the T&Cs at any time during the competition.

17. English law applies and the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts shall prevail.
